

Breeder Agreement for Ear Cropping

Croswell Veterinary Services

The purpose of this document is to demonstrate your understanding of an agreement made between yourself, the breeder, and our veterinary clinic "Croswell Veterinary Services." As demonstrated and agreed upon in the "Consent to Treat" document attached to this document, the ear cropping procedure is a procedure of cosmetically changing the appearance of your puppy/puppies. There are no guaranties for satisfactory outcomes, there are health risk by choosing this elective procedure as severe as death from an anesthetic reaction, and there are always risks of improper healing and defective outcomes from this procedure, which is why having you, the breeder, to do this procedure is of paramount importance to your buyers and the breed overall.

By signing this document, you are agreeing that you will keep the puppies in your possession under your direct 24 hour care and supervision until the ears are completely healed, which usually takes between 10-14 days following our cropping surgical procedure or longer if we deem necessary to have a successful outcome. You understand that we will not respond to your puppy buyer/client, as we have performed NO SURGERY for them, only a procedure for you. You also understand that we will fire you as a client for any future services if you do not comply with this agreement. You will also be responsible for any follow up care for your puppies until their ears are standing erect, upright, and perfect to the breed standard.

By Croswell Veterinary Services providing you a significant breeder discount on each puppy we crop for you, we are relying on you to provide the stringent and very important aftercare to your puppies and your clients until the ears are completely healed and standing.

If you wish to leave the aftercare and follow-up communication between the clients and our clinic, there will be a fee of \$450 (Cash only as a method of payment) per puppy, and we will gladly waive your breeder discount. In this situation, although we recommend against it (and we will explain this to your buyer), the puppy can go to its new owners house the day following the ear cropping procedure if the puppy is properly vaccinated and the owner is in direct contact with us and aware of our explicit aftercare protocol as published on our website "croswellvet.com".
